

PARKS & RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD - consists of seven members serving four-year staggered terms, two being from USD #443 School Board. The purpose of this board is to review all major proposals and propositions for the construction, reconstruction and improvement of public parks and recreation facilities including the acquisition of land for park purposes, the acquisition of major recreational equipment and facilities and the institution of new programs in the recreational system; to make reports and recommendations to the Governing Body on matters referred to it and such further recommendations as deemed advisable; and to receive and act on any matters submitted to it by other department or boards; to review, evaluate and make recommendations on current programs and activities promoted by the Parks and Recreation Department. The board meets monthly.

CONVENTION & VISITORS BUREAU - recommends methods to implement the Convention and Visitors Bureau's mission of promoting Dodge City and the area's resources and assets to meeting planners, group tour operators, travel writers and prospective tourists to bring convention and travel business to Dodge City. The board meets monthly and consists of nine members serving three-year staggered terms including representatives from motel/restaurant/hospitality (3); Chamber of Commerce (1); Boot Hill Museum (1); local attractions (1); and members at large. (3) *Separate application forms are used for this advisory board.*

RECYCLING ADVISORY BOARD - is responsible for overseeing operations of the recycle center and recycling programs. As an affiliate of the Keep America Beautiful organization, the board advises and initiates programs relating to litter, beautification, neighborhood cleanups and graffiti abatement. The seven member board, serving three-year terms, meets the 4th Monday of every month.

DODGE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION - prepares, administers and enforces the zoning and subdivision regulations for the City. The seven member board serves staggered three-year terms and meets monthly on the 2nd Tuesday.

GOLF ADVISORY BOARD - is responsible for developing and reviewing operational policies regarding Mariah Hills Golf Course and providing input to the City Commission and staff. The board is a five member board, three of which are appointed at large by the City Commission and meets quarterly.

SMPC ADVISORY COMMITTEE - provides advice and counsel to the City of Dodge City concerning the support, operation and maintenance of the former St. Mary of the Plains College Campus and facilities. The committee meets every other month and consists of five members, each serving a three-year term.

BUILDING BOARD OF APPEALS - is involved with issues of building construction and permits, reviews and recommends code amendments and changes in building construction methods, and assists the Inspection Department in building code interpretation. Representation should include persons from the design, real estate, general, residential, plumbing, electrical and mechanical contracting professions and other areas of interest. The board consists of seven members and meets annually or as needed for specific issues.

CULTURAL RELATIONS ADVISORY BOARD - advises the City Commission related to or affecting minority communities within Dodge City, to monitor the policies and practices of the City of Dodge City to issue fair and equitable application, and to act as a resource for intercultural awareness, education, and celebration among all people. The board consists of nine members serving staggered three-year terms, meeting monthly at noon on the 2nd Friday.

SANTA FE TRAILS COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS ADVISORY BOARD - participates in the formulation of the comprehensive plan for the development, implementation & operation of correctional services. The City Commission appoints three members to the twelve member board, serving two-year terms, meeting monthly.

The City of Dodge City presently appoints members to various advisory boards/commissions. These groups make recommendations to the City Commission regarding various phases of municipal operations or, in some cases, are responsible for operation of certain programs or facilities. These groups are an excellent place for individuals to assist the City by providing and recommending while learning about local government operations. Listed below are the various commissions and boards and a brief description of the activities of each. Also attached is an application form. If you are interested in serving, please take a few minutes to complete it and return it to the City Manager's office, City Hall, P.O. Box 880, Dodge City, KS 67801-0880. Thank you for your interest.

HOUSING AUTHORITY BOARD -meets monthly, consists of five members serving staggered four-year terms, and is responsible for the administration of public housing in the community.

LIBRARY BOARD - responsible for the sound fiscal management of the library, establishment of the philosophical direction of library services and programming, and all legal and ethical aspects of the library's operation. The board is also responsible for the evaluation of recommendations of the director in light of improving library service, budget, and operations. The board consists of seven members serving staggered four-year terms, meeting monthly.

SHADE TREE COMMISSION - has seven members serving staggered three-year terms. It shall be the responsibility of the board to study, investigate, counsel and develop and/or update annually and administer a written plan for the care, preservation, pruning, planting, replanting, removal or disposition of trees and shrubs in parks and in other public areas. Such plan will be presented annually to the City Commission and upon their acceptance and approval shall constitute the official comprehensive city tree plan for the City. The commission meets monthly with the exception of the summer months when no meetings are held.

AIRPORT ADVISORY BOARD - shall serve in an advisory capacity and make recommendations to the governing body. Recommendations shall include, but not limited to, future development plans, operational needs, and promotional activities. The board shall consist of seven members who will serve a two-year term, meeting quarterly.

HISTORIC LANDMARK COMMISSION - recommends to the City Commission local landmark designations following research regarding historical and architectural significance of each site. In addition, the commission reviews proposed changes to local landmark designations to ensure historical integrity remains in place during renovations. The commission consists of seven members serving staggered three-year terms, meeting quarterly or as needed.
