

ORDINANCE NO. 3644

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE INSTALLATION OF A STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF 4<sup>th</sup> AVENUE EXTENDED AND THE INTERNAL WRIGHT PARK ROADWAY JUST SOUTH OF THE LONG BRANCH LAGOON WATER PARK AND AT THE INTERSECTION OF PARK STREET AND THE NORTH/SOUTH INTERNAL WRIGHT PARK ROADWAY JUST EAST OF THE DETENTION HOLDING FACILITIES ALONG WITH ESTABLISHING NO PARKING ON THE NORTH CURB LINE OF THE INTERNAL WRIGHT PARK ROADWAY JUST SOUTH OF THE LONG BRANCH LAGOON WATER PARK FROM 4<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE EXTENDED WEST 490 FEET AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DODGE CITY:

Section 1: A stop sign shall be installed at the intersection of 4<sup>TH</sup> AVE. extended and the internal Wright Park Roadway just south of the Long Branch Lagoon Water Park, stopping traffic on the internal Wright Park Roadway at the intersection.

Section 2: A stop sign shall be installed at the intersection of PARK ST. and the North/South internal Wright Park Roadway just east of the detention holding facilities, stopping traffic on the internal Wright Park Roadway at the intersection.

Section 3: Any person convicted of a violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to penalties provided by Chapter I, Section 1-116 of the Code of the City of Dodge City.

Section 4: Standing, stopping or parking shall be prohibited along the north curb line of the internal Wright Park Roadway just south of the Long Branch Lagoon Water Park from 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. extended west 490 feet.

Section 5: Any person convicted of the violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to penalties in accordance with the provisions of Article 20, of the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas cities, prepared and published by the League of Kansas Municipalities Edition 2016, and adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Dodge City, and as set out in Section 14.101 of the Code of the City of Dodge City.

Section 6: This ordinance shall take effect following its publication in the official City newspaper as provided by law, and after the posting of appropriate signs advising the motoring public of the provisions of this ordinance.
