Subject: Approval of the Repainting of the Mural at the First National Bank

Agenda Item: New Business

Purpose: Approval for the repainting of the Remington Mural located on the First National Bank

Recommendation: Approve the Proposal by Stan Herd in the amount of \$44,000. Further approving the City staff to rent a boom truck for the amount of \$8,000, provide paint materials (\$1,000) and the cost of Hotel Rooms.

Background: City Administration approached Stan Herd a few weeks ago to inquire about the possibility of finding someone to touch up the mural on the First National Bank Building. To our surprise Stan Herd stated that he would be interested in doing the work himself with his team this winter. His team is currently in between projects which are slated to begin towards the end of this winter. He stated that if the weather was above 40 degrees he could clean the mural and prep the wall for repainting, and could paint as long as the temperature was above 50 degrees while painting. Mr. Herd reached out to us on December 18th, stating that the next few weeks looked beautiful, and he would like to begin his project as soon as possible. This item was slated to be on the special meeting for December 30th of this month. I am requesting the Commission to consider the proposal from Stan Herd in the amount of \$44,000. The Rental equipment, which is a 135 ft boom truck will cost no more than \$8,000 for the month, plus \$1,000 for paint materials. However, we are working with the rental company to get this cost reduced. The unknown is the 2 hotel rooms required for their stay while working on the project, and the nights needed. If approved Stan Herd will be in town on Sunday evening and begin work Monday morning.

Financial Considerations: The funds will come from the 2% transient guest tax that is uncommitted to the CVB or Boot Hill, we have approximately \$600,000 in reserve in that fund currently. I anticipate the cost to the City to be approximately \$60k for the total cost to the City including the boom truck and hotel.
